## I. HIS CALL

- A. His Salvation and Assurance
  - 1. Salvation
    - a. Born again child of God
    - b. Testimony
  - 2. Assurance
    - a. It is of the upmost importance that he has a full assurance of his own salvation.
      - i. No man can pluck him out of the Father's hand (John 10:29)
      - ii. To know that you are his disciple by your love of the brethren (John 13:35; 1 John 3:10-14)
      - iii. To know that you have eternal life (1 John 5:13)
    - b. Without this assurance (salvation and trust in God) he will not be able to be a faithful, and effective witness for Christ.
      - i. The example of Paul (1 Timothy 1:12-17)
      - ii. The example of Peter (note: this example is from before Christ's death on the cross and is a loose application.) The shacking of Peter's faith.
        - 1) Peter's confidence (John 13:36-38)
        - 2) Peter's confrontation (John 18:10-12)
        - 3) Peter's contradiction (John 18:25-27)
        - 4) Peter's recovery (John 21:1-7, 15-19; Acts 2:14, 41)
- B. His Service and Faithfulness
  - 1. Service in his local church
    - a. Is he active already in a ministry?
    - b. How long has he been active?
      - i. It is strongly suggested that the individual(s) have some level of experience in a ministry.
      - ii. This will be helpful for him/them as they move forward in preparation.

  - a. The importance (2 Corinthians 4:2)
    - i. One of the first requirements
    - ii. The example of Timothy (1 Corinthians 4:17)
    - iii. The example of Tychicus (Colossians 4:7)
  - b. The level
    - i. This cannot be stressed enough.
    - ii. If the individual cannot be faithful here, do not expect him to make it on deputation or the field.
    - iii. Laziness cannot be a part of the individual (1 Corinthians 4:2, 17; Luke 16:10-12)

  - 1. The Calling
    - a. From the Lord (Acts 13:2-4)
    - b. Not by man (Galatians 1:1; 1 Timothy 1:11-14)
  - 2. The Assurance of the Calling
    - a.To confirm the call (2 Timothy 3:14-17)
      - 1. Through God's word
      - 2. Through fasting and time with Him
    - b. To continue in the calling (2 Timothy 3:14)
  - 3. Testimonies of Callings
    - a. David Livingston
    - b. John G. Paton
    - c. Adoniram Judson
    - d. James M. Thoburn
