## The Acts of the Apostles I The Salvation of Cornelius Acts 10:1-48

## I. THE VISION IN CAESAREA (Acts 10:1-8)

Jeremiah 29:13 And ye shall seek me, and find *me*, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.

- iii. The instructions of the Lord (Acts 10:5-6; Acts 9:43) Send men to Joppa (Joppa [modern day Tel-Aviv] approx. 30 miles south of Caesarea).

Leviticus 11:4 Nevertheless these shall ye not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the hoof: *as* the camel, because he cheweth the cud, but divideth not the hoof; he *is* unclean unto you. **5** And the coney, because he cheweth the cud, but divideth not the hoof; he *is* unclean unto you. **6** And the hare, because he cheweth the cud, but divideth not the hoof; he *is* unclean unto you. **7** And the swine, though he divide the hoof, and be clovenfooted, yet he cheweth not the cud; he *is* unclean to you. **8** Of their flesh shall ye not eat, and their carcase shall ye not touch; they *are* unclean to you.

Leviticus 11:9 These shall ye eat of all that *are* in the waters: whatsoever hath fins and scales in the waters, in the seas, and in the rivers, them shall ye eat. 10 And all that have not fins and scales in the seas, and in the rivers, of all that move in the waters, and of any living thing which *is* in the waters, they *shall be* an abomination unto you: 11 They shall be even an abomination unto you; ye shall not eat of their flesh, but ye shall have their carcases in abomination.

Leviticus 11:13 And these *are they which* ye shall have in abomination among the fowls; they shall not be eaten, they *are* an abomination: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the ospray,
