II. VARYING VIEWS OF THE CHURCH

A. The Church Is a Building

- 1. The word *church* is used to denote both a Christian association of people and a place of worship. The word *church* is usually, but not exclusively, associated with Christianity.
- 2. Therefore, the church is a house consecrated to the worship of God, among Christians—the Lord's house.
- 3. This concept is derived from verses like 1 Timothy 3:15.
- 4. Historically, saints referred to the place of worship as a meeting-house.

B. The Church Consists of a Local Body of Believers

- 1. The New Testament Church is a local assembly of baptized believers who have united for the purpose of carrying out the Great Commission.
- 2. The church consists of a body of baptized believers who have banded together to fully perform the teachings of scripture.

C. The Church Is Made Up of All the Saved

- 1. The church is the collective body of all who have been truly born again.
 - a. In this sense, the church is sometimes called *catholic* or *universal*.
 - b. It is often broken down to a "visible" church and "invisible" church.
 - c. On a smaller scale, the church can consist of the saved in a particular locale (i.e., the church of Ephesus, or of Antioch).
- 2. The visible church, also known as the local church, consists of those who have believed on the Lord Jesus Christ and assemble together. It is identified as a visible church because its members are...
 - a. Known
 - b. Assemble
- 3. The invisible, or universal, church consists of the whole number of born again believers. This church is identified as the body of Christ and is called invisible because...
 - a. Some of its members are in heaven
 - b. Those on earth cannot be fully known for this church does not assemble
