The Study of an Event

I. LOCATING THE EVENT IN SCRIPTURE

A. Using the Scripture

- 1. Find ALL accounts of the event.
- 2. The event could be found primarily in Exodus and Numbers, yet you could find key verses in the Psalms, Hebrews, or somewhere else.

B. Using Other Resources

- 1. One of the best resources would be the *Treasury of Scripture Knowledge*.
- 2. There are also resources that deal with specific events found in scripture.
- 3. Commentaries might lend some help in the research of an event.

II. LOCATE INFORMATION CONCERNING THE EVENT

A. Details of the Event

- 1. What are the individual details of the event?
- 2. Do some details seem to contradict other details? If so, what is the solution?

B. People

- 1. Who associated with the event?
- 2. Who is the major person connected to this event? How does this relate to other events involving this person?
- 3. What is the role of each member of the trinity in the event?

C. Places

- 1. What places are associated with the event?
- 2. Was the place prophesied in scripture?

D. Time

- 1. What is the timeframe in which the event occurred?
- 2. What other events occurred at the same time?

E. Prophecy

- 1. What prophecies were given concerning this event?
- 2. Have all of the prophecies concerning this event been fulfilled?
