 - 1. The sinner does evil an hundred times (1 Kings 21:25)
 - 2. Though Ahab reigned for 22 years in Samaria (1 Kings 16:29)
 - ii. It shall not go well (Ecclesiastes 8:13)
 - 1. Ahab will die an awful death (1 Kings 22:29-38)
 - 2. The licking of the blood by the dogs (1 Kings 22:28; see 1 Kings 21:19)

 - i. On this earth (v. 12)
 - 1. Days of the wicked
 - a. The prolonged life of the wicked (Ecclesiastes 7:15)
 - b. The reward of the wicked (Isaiah 3:10-11)
 - c. This side of eternity is the only pleasure that the unsaved will have, in eternity they will face having to pay for their own sins.
 - 2. Days of the righteous
 - a. It shall be well with those that fear God
 - i. They are blessed (Psalm 112:1)
 - ii. The upright's inheritance shall be forever (Psalm 37:18-19)
 - b. Which fear before God
 - i. The righteous shall be quiet from fear of evil (Proverbs 1:32-33)
 - ii. The fear of the LORD is strong confidence (Proverbs 14:26)
 - ii. Of eternity (v. 13)
 - 1. The wicked man's end (Ecclesiastes 8:13)
 - a. Their days are as a shadow (Job 14:2; Psalm 144:4)
 - b. Their days are as an handbreath (Psalm 39:5)
 - c. At the point of death (Hebrews 9:27-28) (Luke 16:23-24)
 - d. At the great white throne judgment (Revelation 20:11-15)
